MAIN PROJECTS:

RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND HIGH-YIELD FARMING

Integrated development projects for farming businesses in Mexico, Colombia, Costa Rica and Chile. In addition to infrastructure, the company also provides instruction on use of infrastructure and farming practices which guarantee both the continuity of the projects and maximum crop yield. Financing: Private funds.

Experimental centre project for Algeria's I.T.C.M. (Institute technique des cultures Maraicheres et Industrielles) involving the installation of advanced agricultural technological infrastructure and supplying the technology transfer required for commissioning. Financing: the project was managed jointly with TRAGSA with funds provided by the Andalusian Regional Government (Spain).

IRRIGATION INFRASTRUCTURES. HYDRAULIC WORKS

Project for the construction of a hydraulic network to replace traditional irrigation by localised flooding for the Sagunto Irrigation Union, Valencia (Spain). The facilities benefited 1,400 members of the Sagunto Irrigation Union, covering a surface of some 450 Has. Financing: European Union, FEDER Funds.

Project for the construction of a hydraulic network to replace traditional irrigation by localised flooding for the San Onofre Irrigation Community, Murcia (Spain). The project benefited 300 farmers, and included facilities to pump water from wells, filtering systems, and automatic ferti-irrigation systems, as well as automatic irrigation with volume control per farmer with electrification and electronic connections. Financing: European Union, FEDER Funds.

Project for the construction of a drinking water supply system for the town of Hornos del Segura, Jaen (Spain). Financing: Andalusian Regional Government.

WATER TREATMENT

Project for the installation of a desalination plant with capacity for 19,600 m³/day in San Quintin, Baja California (Mexico). Training courses to teach operators how to use and manage the facility were organised during the installation period. Financing: Private funds.

Several projects for treating waste water produced by agrifood industrial processes in various areas: Almazara SCA San Isidro Labrador, Canena, Jaen (Spain), Bodega Hermanos Duque en Fuensaldaña, Valladolid (Spain), Bodega Martin Berdugo, Aranda de Duero, Burgos (Spain). Financing: Private funds.

Several projects for disinfecting drainage waters from hydroponic crops to be subsequently reused by private farms in Almeria (Spain). Financing: Private funds.
